A Place Where People and Plants Can Grow

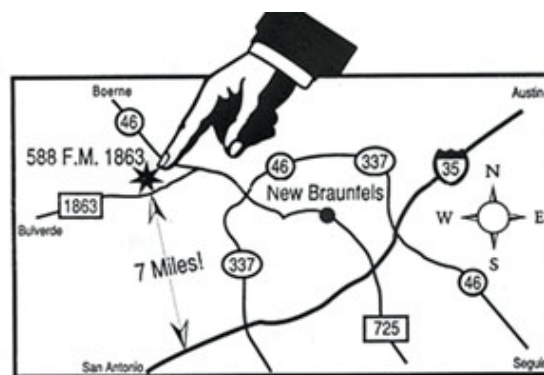
